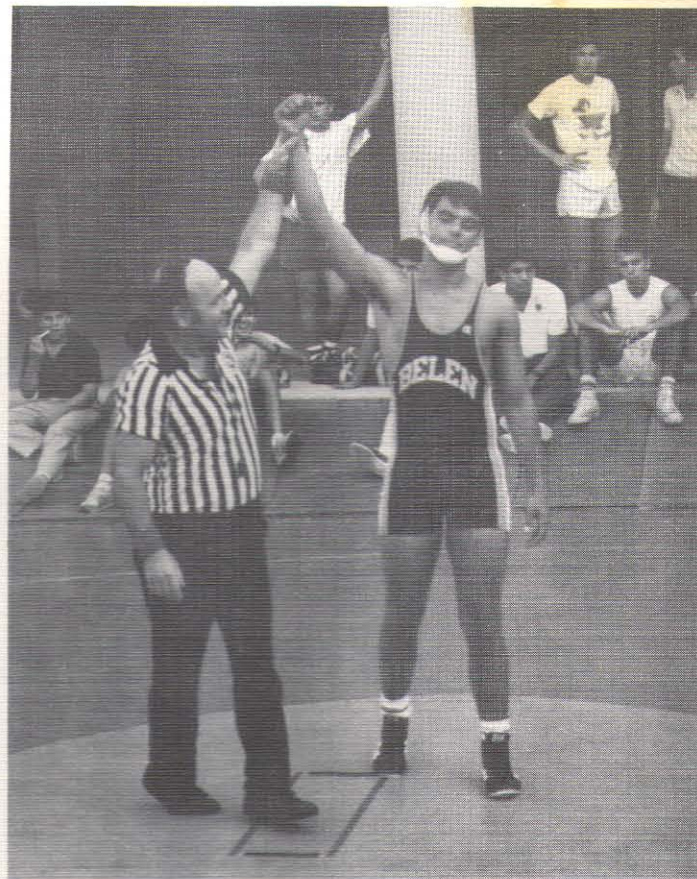

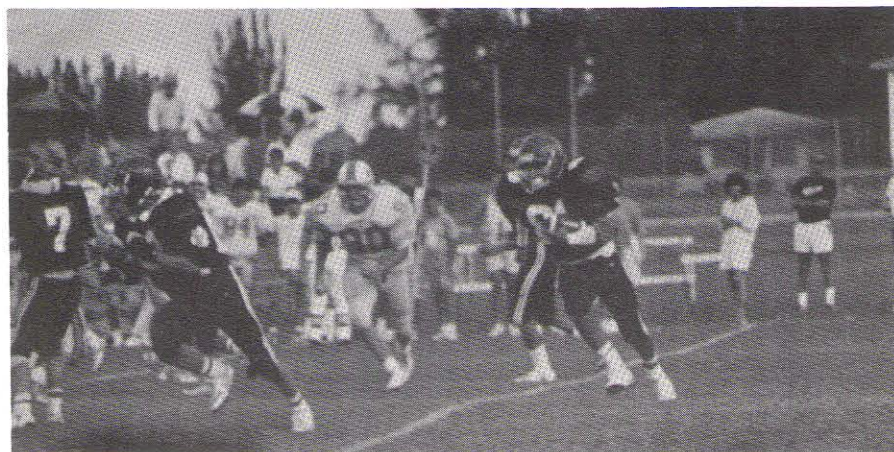
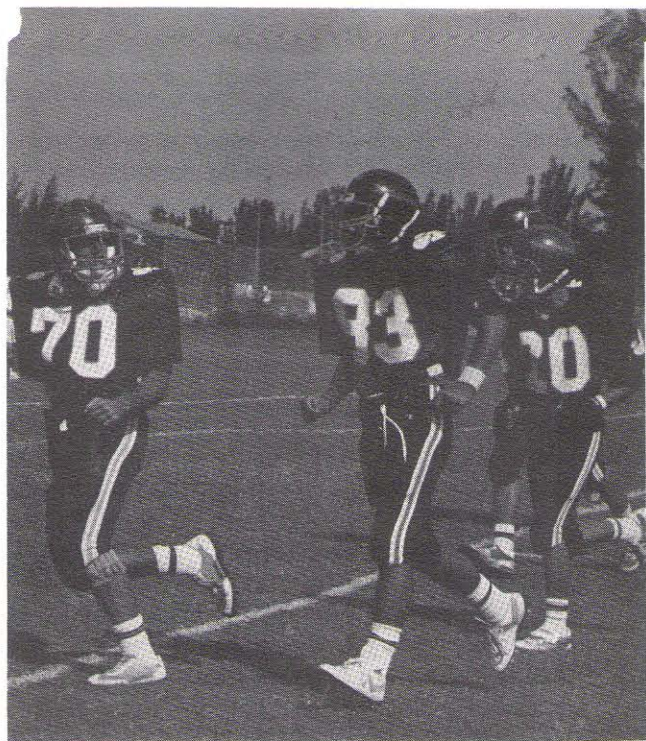
# Varsity Football Team

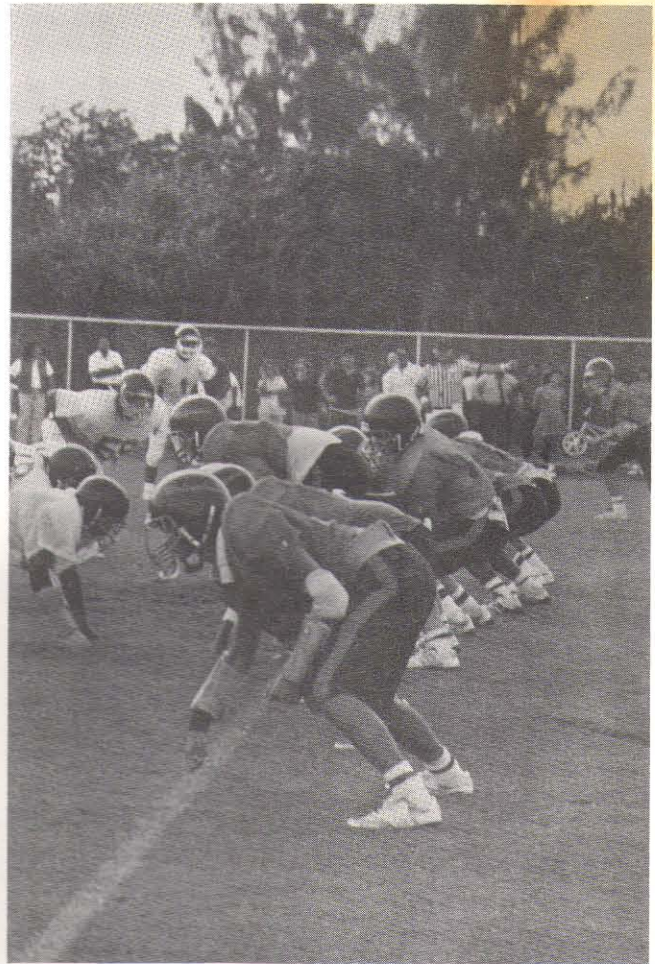

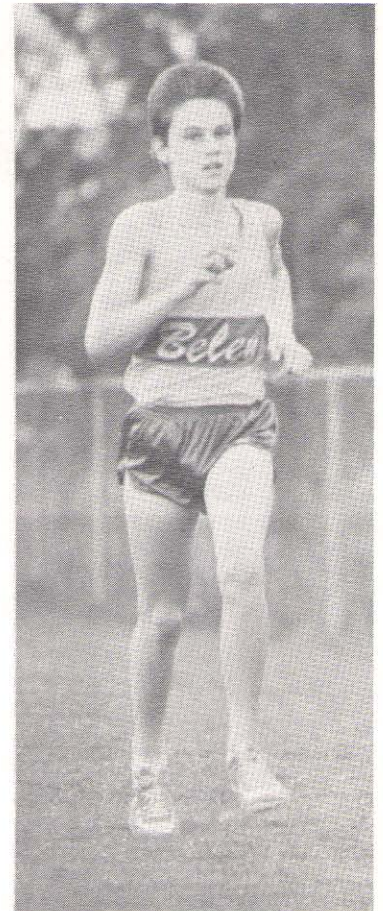
The highlight of the season was at the State Championships where Belen upset Clewiston for the states's runner-up spot.

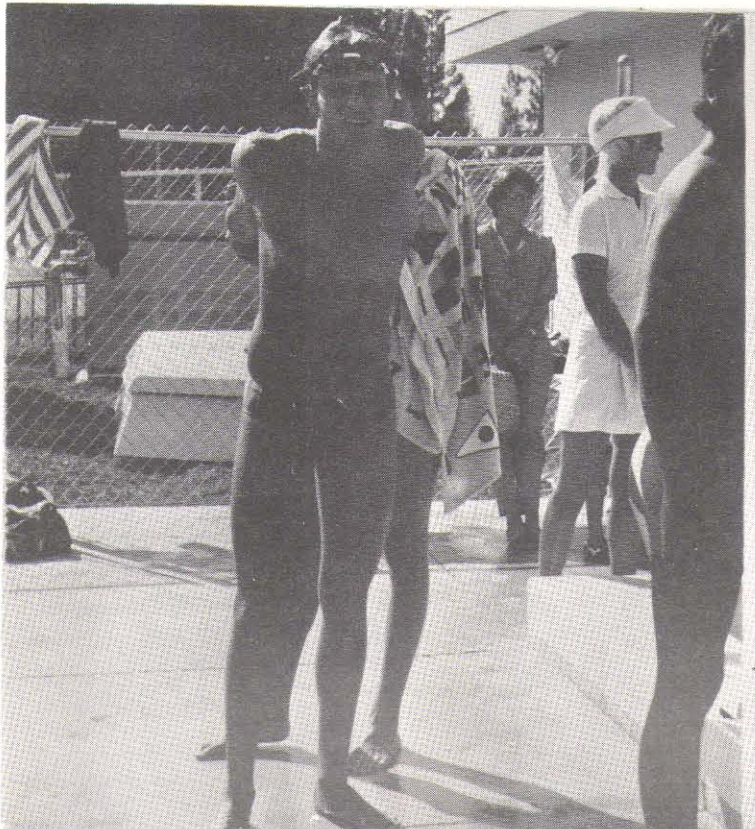
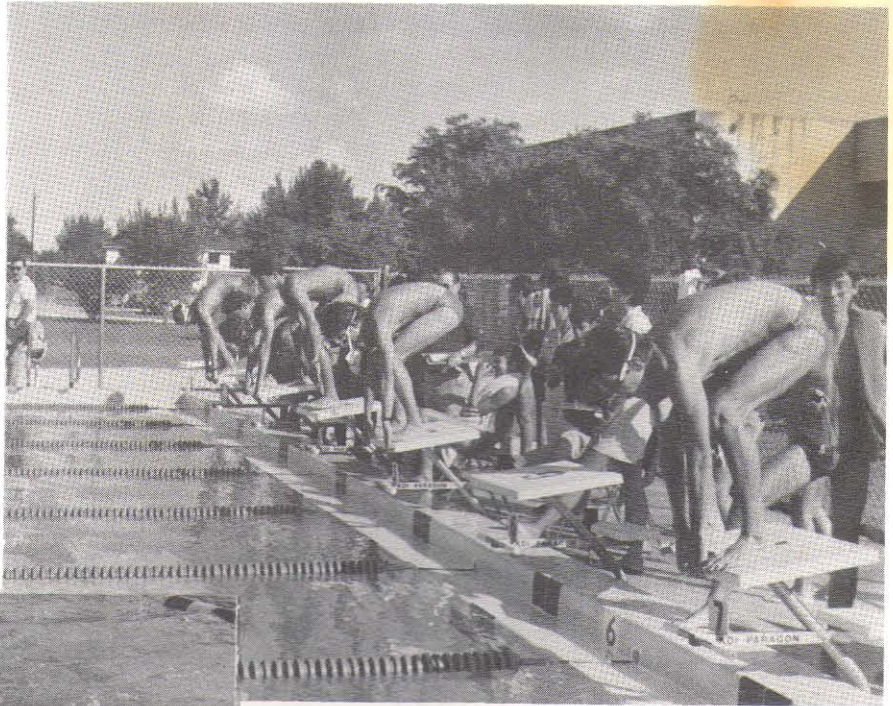


# Swimming Team

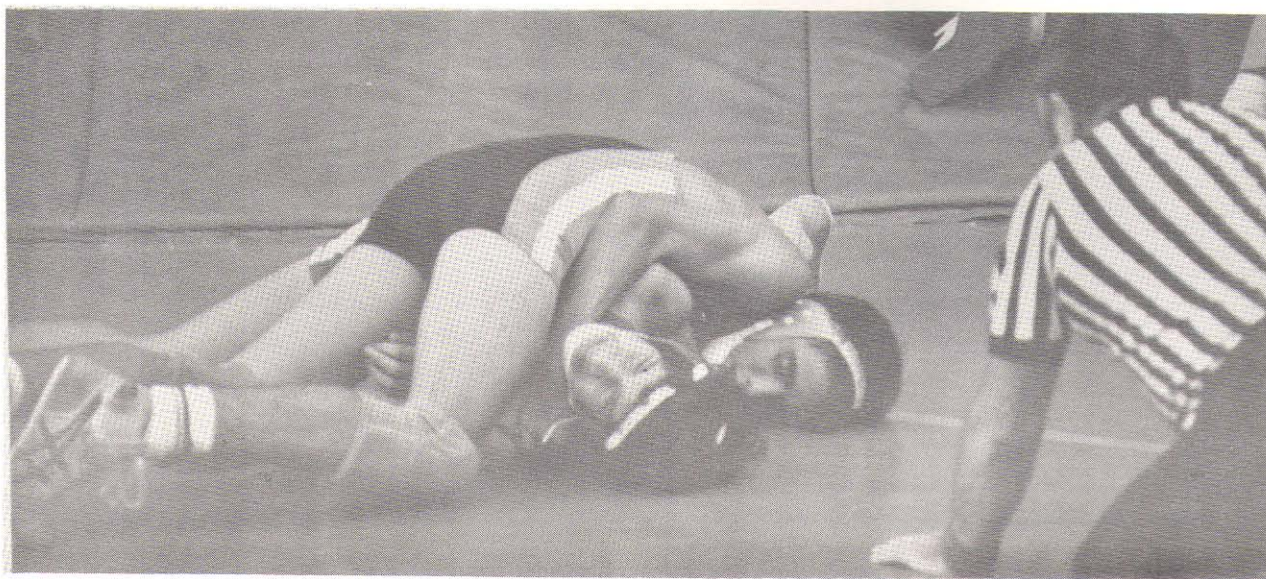
## Varsity Wrestling Team

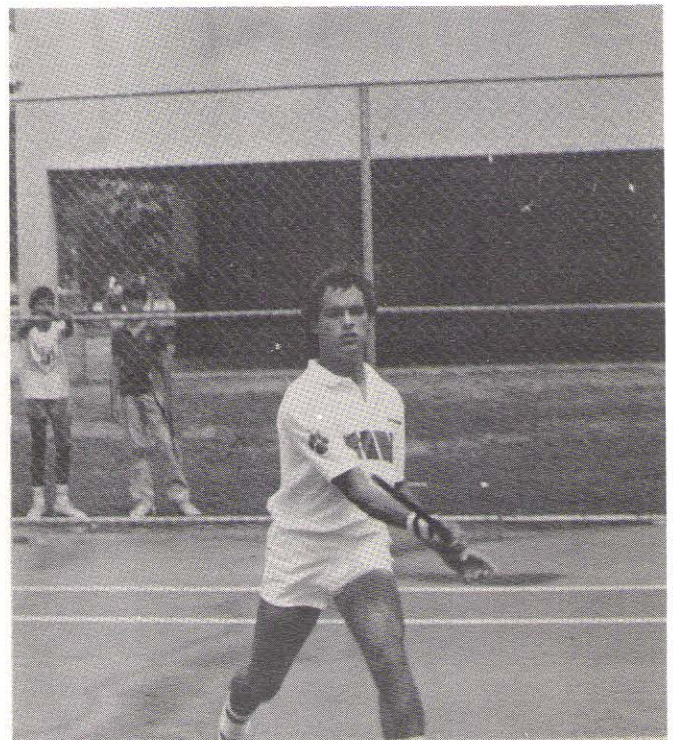
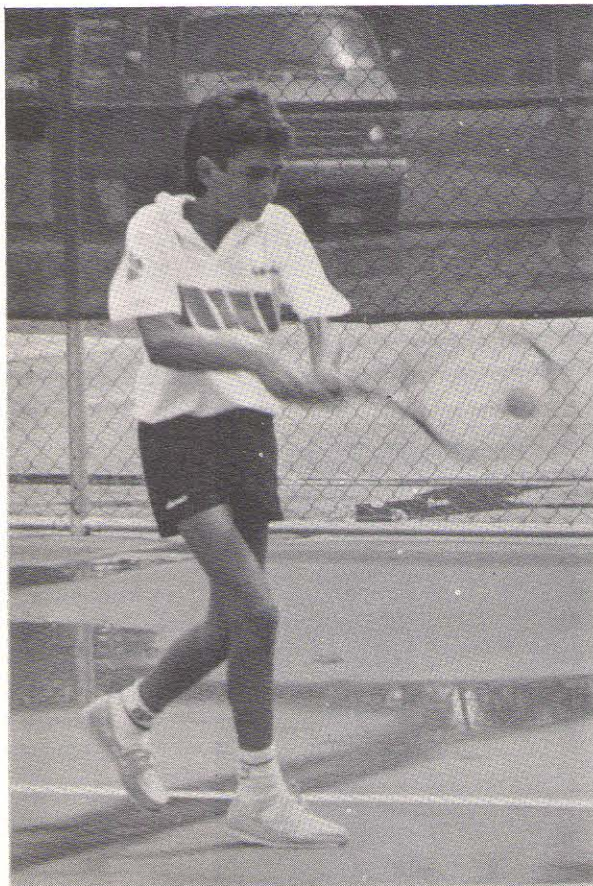

Congratulations to the team for your togetherness and dedication and good luck to our departing Seniors Héctor Tundidor, Mario Rodríguez and Manny Hadad.

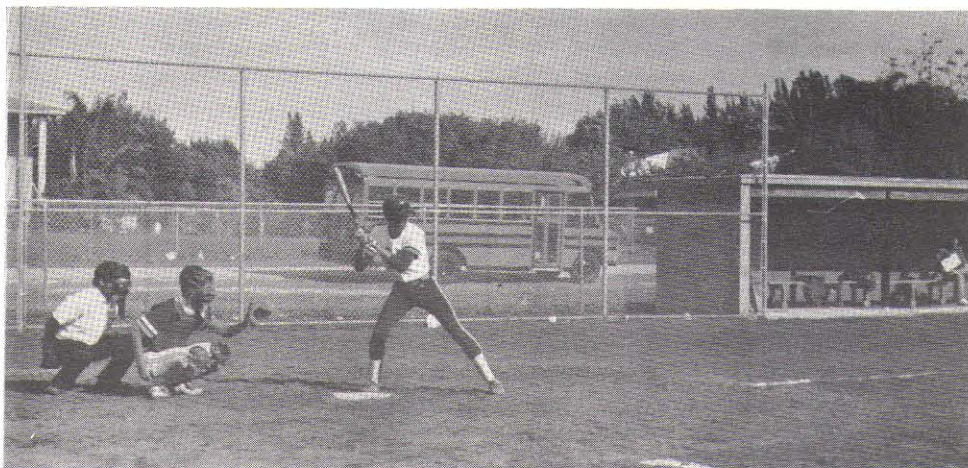
